

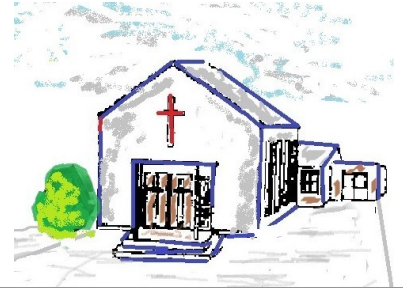

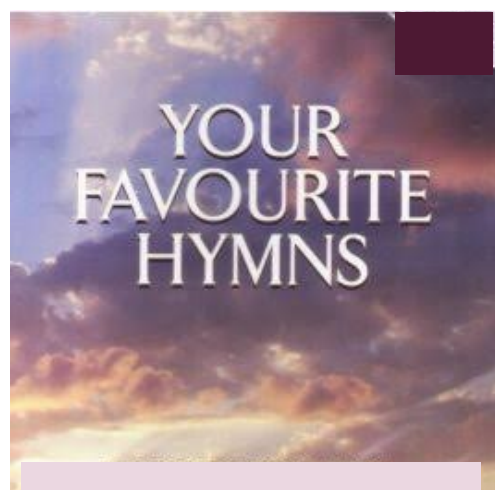


Another Diary Date
